INFORMATION OBLIGATION

1. The Controller of the personal data collected during the recruitment process is the Institute of Genetics and Animal Biotechnology of the Polish Academy of Sciences, entered in the register of institutes of the Polish Academy of Sciences (maintained by the Polish Academy of Sciences) under number RIN-V-32/98, NIP 1230018381, REGON 000326196, with its registered address at: Jastrzębiec, ul. Postępu 36A, 05-552 Magdalenka, Poland.
2. Personal data provided to the Controller by participants in the recruitment process will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ.EU.L. of 2016 No. 119/1, hereinafter referred to as "**GDPR**").
3. Pursuant to Articles 5, 6, 7 and 13 of GDPR, the Controller informs that:
 - a. Personal data provided by the participant in the recruitment process will be processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR, i.e. on the basis of their consent and pursuant to Article 22¹ of the act of 26 June 1974 Labour Code (Journal of Laws 2018 item 917).
 - b. The following personal data are processed during the recruitment process: first name(s) and surname, image, names of parents, date of birth, place of residence (correspondence address), education, other personal details of the employee, including names and surnames and dates of birth of the employee's children, where providing such data is necessary for the employee to exercise specific rights provided for under labour law, the employee's PESEL number assigned by the Government Information Center of the Universal Electronic System for Registration of the Population (RCI PESEL), telephone number and e-mail address.
 - c. A person participating in the recruitment process has the right to request access to their personal data, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to



- object to the processing of their data, the right to data portability, and the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.
- d. A person participating in the recruitment process has the right to withdraw their consent to the processing of their personal data at any time. Withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal
 - e. Providing personal data by a person participating in the recruitment process is voluntary; however, failure to provide such data may make it impossible to carry out the recruitment process.
